

## Bishopscourt, Rochester, 2016

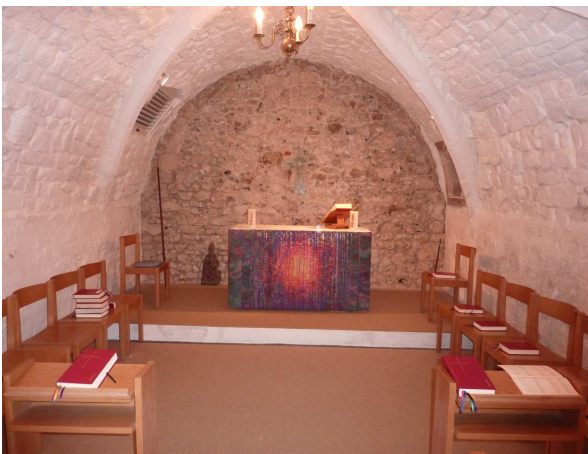
### Limited availability for parish quiet days or one day retreats.

Bishopscourt, from 1920 to the present day, the residence of the Bishop of Rochester, is a large, part Georgian part Victorian house with an enclosed garden. It provides peaceful, contemplative spaces which lend themselves to use by small groups who require a suitable venue for a quiet day or similar.

Groups, of no more than 20 people, will have use of the following areas for their quiet day:

- Hall and reception area
- Drawing Room, with grand piano
- Crypt chapel, with seating for 14 - 20
- Dining Room
- Pantry
- Kitchen
- Garden

### Crypt Chapel



Tea and coffee will be made available, but all other catering will be the responsibility of the group. The kitchen will be available if groups want to heat previously prepared food, or groups may prefer to bring sandwiches etc.

### Drawing Room



There is limited parking available so car sharing is advised. Rochester railway station is 5 minutes walk away.
